

## Properly cared for leather lasts longer

- Protect the leather from direct sunlight, extreme heat and sharp objects
- Always remove dirt and soiling as quickly as possible. This is the best way to prevent residues
- Clean the leather regularly with a damp cloth
- Clean the leather gently using a circular motion with a cloth and very mild soap solution
- Dry and polish the leather with a dry cloth
- Avoid saturating the leather
- Avoid chemical cleaning agents containing solvents such as alcohol and benzene
- Test all cleaning agents in an inconspicuous area beforehand
- Never rub vigorously and in one place (risk of damaging the surface)
- Please consult your nearest specialist dealer in the case of heavy soiling particularly chemical stains containing lubricants, tar or dyes! Of course, we are available at all times for your assistance.
